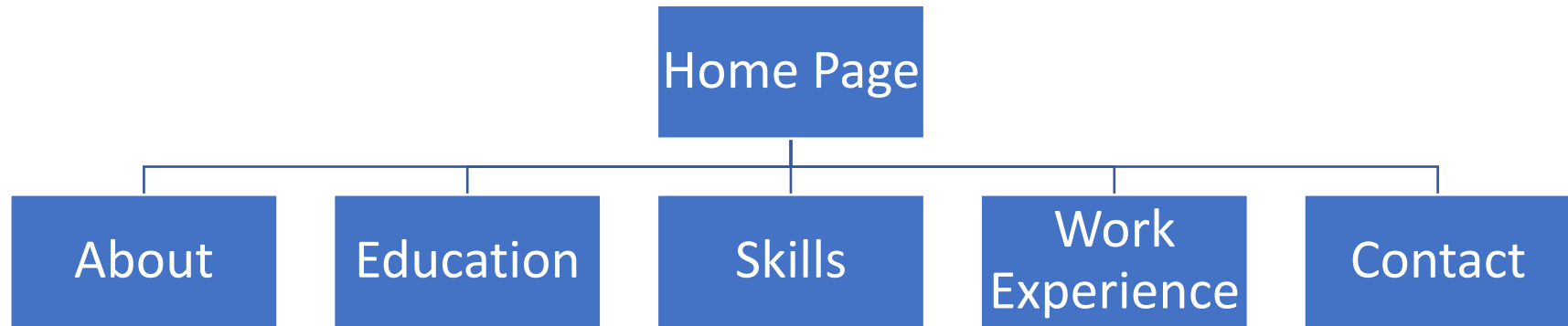
Allowing oneself to be creative is the next advantage. We may be more expressive with our input while constructing a website, giving readers the sense that it is more personal and attracting them to the contents.
